Solbosch site

From the Central Station

Take the bus N° 71 towards Delta. Get off at stop "ULB".

From the South Station

Take metro line N° 2 (towards Simonis Elisabeth) and get off at stop "Porte de Namur". From there take the bus N° 71 (towards Delta) and get off at "ULB".

Or : take metro line N° 2 (same direction) and get off at "Louise". Then take the tram 94 (towards Herrmann-Debroux) until the stop "ULB".

PROGRAMME

In recent years, the overprescription of psychiatric drugs has become the subject of frequent public debate in Europe and the US.

In March 2010, the Belgian Minister of Social Affairs and Public Health, announced to the Senate that a plan to tackle the overconsumption of psychotropic drugs was in preparation.

The symposium will attempt to analyse this social phenomenon along two different lines.

The first issue to be addressed is the scientific basis for the prescription of these drugs; how was it constructed and is there any scope for questioning its validity?

The second issue concerns the question of disease categorization, the distinction between mental pathology and the ups and downs of daily life, and the impact of disease-mongering on how we perceive ourselves.
